Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Teach knowledge and skills, nurture confidence and character, and meet the needs of all students by utilizing SESI instructional models, strategies, and curriculum
- Use assessment data to modify short and long-term plans to promote all students' academic performance
- Develop and maintain skill-appropriate lesson plans
- Develop and maintain student forms and files as required by SESI Schools, local, state, and/or federal agencies
- Collaborate with staff to promote an environment of critical thinking and academic rigor
- Utilize school's behavior support and intervention strategies
- Implement de-escalation techniques, crisis management to maintain the safety of students and staff
- Drive, record, and track student growth and progress towards goals
- Participate in the daily functions of the school such as morning, lunch, and afternoon supervisory duties.
- Attending and documenting conferences, meetings, and training with supervisors
- Light lifting, walking, and/or climbing stairs may be required
- Collaborate with SEAPCO Academy Staff to provide support to students through co-teaching or as Crisis Intervention Staff
